caffè latte

[kaf'fɛ l'latte]

means "milk coffee", a combination of fine oro espresso and rich frothed milk. the term 'café au lait' has traditionally been used in northern europe and scandinavia to refer a caffè latte.



flat white

[flæt wait]

a coffee beverage that originated in australia. prepared by pouring microfoam, steamed milk consisting of fine bubbles with a glossy or velvety consistency, over a single shot of smooth oro espresso.



cappuccino

[kapput'tʃi:nɔ]

an italian coffee drink that is traditionally prepared with a shot of espresso, rich frothed milk and topped with sprinkles of italian chocolate powder.



macchiato

[mmak'kja:to]

fine extracted oro espresso with a dash of frothed milk. in italian, macchiato means "stained" and the literal translation of caffè macchiato is "stained coffee", or coffee with a spot of milk.



affogato

[afə'gɑ:təʊ]

a scoop of vanilla ice cream topped with a shot of hot espresso. it is considered one drink, not a combination of coffee and ice cream.



mocaccino (mocha)

[mokat'tʃi:nɔ]

mocha is based on fine oro espresso extract and rich frothed milk, but with an extra italian chocolate shot delivering a smooth coffee drink.



hot chocolate

[hot tʃɔ:klət]

a combination of italian chocolate and fine frothed milk, with generous chocolate sprinkles over the surface of the foam.



chai latte

[tʃai l'latte]

a spicy drink of black tea with cardamom, cinnamon, black pepper, and star anise added to steamed milk. chai latte has become a staple of coffee shops and tea houses.



babyccino

[beibi'tʃi:nəʊ]

a drink of frothed milk without coffee. as a coffee-free cappuccino, as the name indicates, and topped with chocolate sprinkles and marshmallow.



caffè americano (long black coffee)

[kaf'fɛ ameri'ka:no]

double shots of the finest extracted oro espresso together with its rich cream, gently poured into hot H2O.



espresso

[es'presso]

100% arabica oro coffee beans, perfectly grinded to the notch as to extract from the espresso machine creating one smooth and outstanding coffee character.
